



## **Chesapeake Conference Sevens Points System**

*(Modified January 2018)*

For the mandatory Conference tournament prior to the Conference Championship, points will be provided in the respective order of finish — with first place receiving 9 points, and last place receiving 1 point.

The Conference will also sponsor up to three additional open tournaments, which will be open to clubs from other collegiate conferences, and are optional for clubs within our conference to participate. To encourage the participation of Conference clubs in these open tournaments, points will be awarded to Chesapeake Conference teams — but only to the top three finishing Conference teams. 3 points provided to the highest, 2 points for the second highest, 1 point for the third highest.

(Example: *NonConTeam1* places 1st in the tournament, Maryland 2nd, *NonConTeam2* 3rd, VA Tech 4th, Georgetown 5th.

Maryland would receive 3 points towards Conference Championship seeding, VA Tech 2 points and Georgetown 1 point)

Points will then be added together from both the mandatory and optional tournament events to determine each club's seed for the mandatory Conference Championship Tournament.

In the event of a tie for seeding, tiebreaker would be result of **1)** Club with higher tournament participation **2)** final point differential and **3)** Head-to-Head record.

### **Tournament Scoring**

3 points will be awarded for a win, 2 points for a draw, 1 point for a loss. In case teams are tied after pool play, the tiebreakers are:

- 1) Head-to-head result between the tied teams.
- 2) Difference in points scored and allowed during pool play.
- 3) Points scored during pool play.
- 4) Coin toss.
